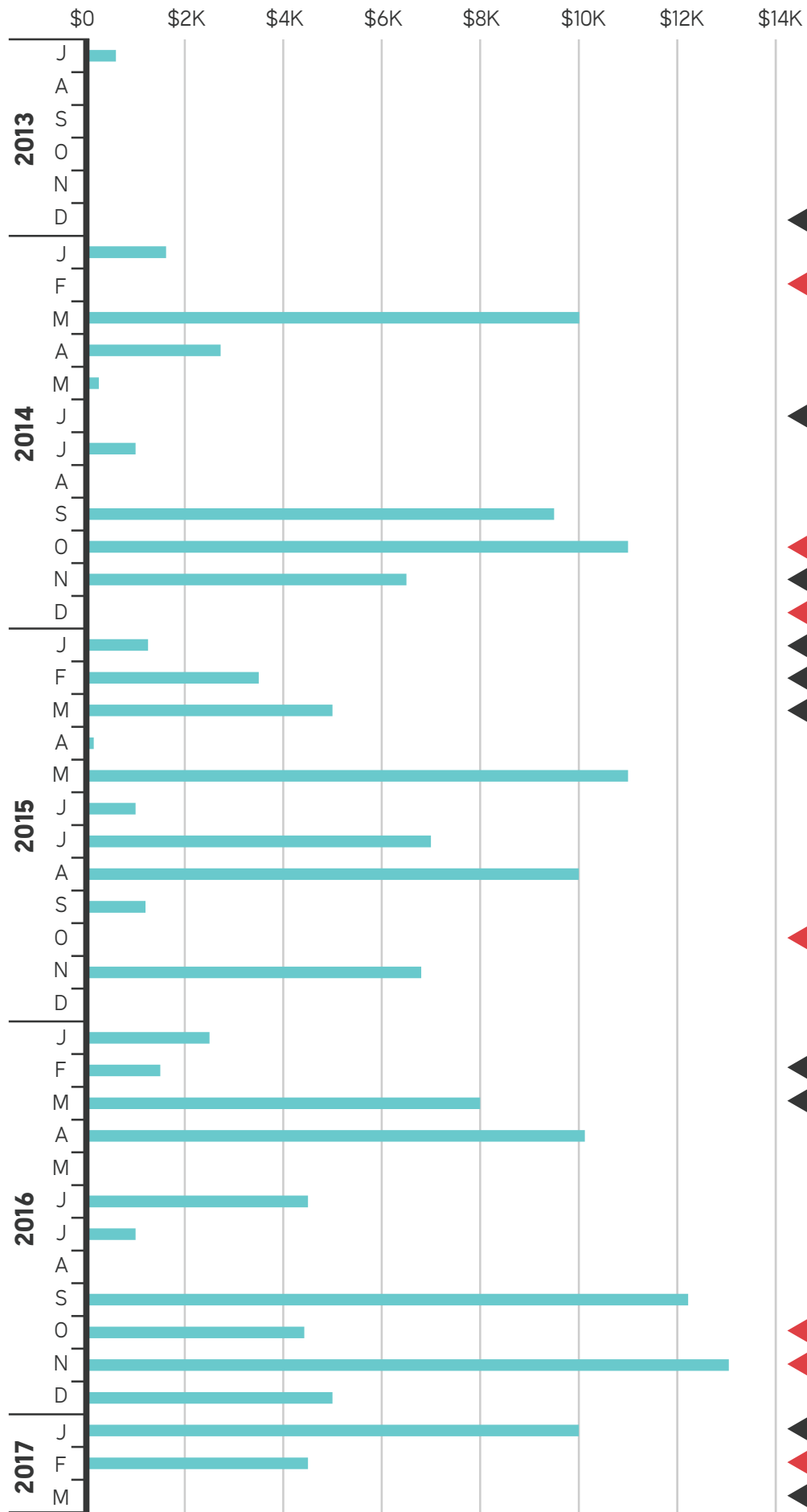




Linking donations from Woodfibre LNG to BC Liberals with political favours

← 21st October 2014 BC Liberals unveil Bill 6, the LNG Income Tax Act, which halves the tax on LNG export facilities to 3.5% rate on net income

← 28th November 2014 Application for EA certificate for Woodfibre LNG submitted to BC EAO

← November 2014 Woodfibre LNG receives certificate of compliance from B.C.'s Environment Ministry for purchase of Woodfibre site

← 22nd January 2015 Public comment period starts through BC EAO

← 6th February 2015 Woodfibre LNG purchases Woodfibre site from Western Forest Products

← 23rd March 2015 Public comment period ends through BC EAO

← 19th October 2015 Ministers Rich Coleman & Mary Polak issue Provincial EA certificate

← 18th March 2016 CEAA approves Woodfibre LNG's Federal EA certificate

← 18th October 2016 Minister Rich Coleman poses for photographs with Sukanto Tanoto and signs MOU that they refuse to release to media

← 4th November 2016 Christy Clark announces eDrive subsidy for Woodfibre LNG worth \$46 million annually. "Project is a go."
